AS SUCH, THE TAXPAYER MEETS THE REOUIREMENTS OF INTERNAL REVENUE CODE SECTION 170(B)(1)(A)(VII), 170(B)(1)(F)(II), AND 4942(H) AS A FOUNDATION QUALIFYING FOR THE INCREASED CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION LIMITS GENERALLY AFFORDED TO PUBLIC CHARITIES.
